

Leadership: The capacity and will to rally people to a common purpose together with the character that inspires confidence and trust.



How...are things changing?

Kerbside waste management

- Export markets closed
- Recyclable material stockpiling
- EPA bans have closed two facilities
 - Material now going to landfill
 - Moonee Valley City Council
 - City of Darebin
- E-waste banned from landfill from July



How...are things changing?

Local Government Bill

- Reforms the LG Act 1989
- Introduced in 2018 (lapsed)
- Will be re-introduced in 2019
- Expected to mandate:
 - 10-year Community Vision
 - 10-year Financial Plan
 - 10-year Asset Plan



How...are things changing?

Engineers Registration Bill 2019

- Introduced & blocked in 2018
- Passed Lower House in May 2019
 - Min. qualification requirement
 - 4-year Degree
 - Min. experience requirement
 - 5 years relevant work
 - Min. professional development
 - 150hrs/3 years






