

Capital works interactive map and resident updates

Every year, Council invests over \$160 million in improving road, transport and drainage infrastructure throughout the Central Coast region. These works are planned in advance through Council's Delivery Program and are identified in more detail in Council's annual Operational Plan.

Through all forms of community engagement, roads and drainage are always a top priority. Our community is passionate about connecting the Central Coast through a quality network of roads, footpaths and shared pathways. Council shares that passion which will see Council in 2018/19 deliver more than 570 projects at an investment of almost \$75 million.

With this importance placed on our infrastructure, Council wanted to ensure the community was kept up to date and had the ability to easily see what projects were planned and where the funds were being spent.

Council has developed an interactive map to help local residents see what road, transport and drainage capitals works are planned in their neighbourhood. The map features details on each project such as the project scope, description, a timeline for commencement and completion, and a monthly update on the progress. Significant projects also have concept and design plans available as well as photos.

Often our community were unaware of the road, transport and drainage projects Council delivers each year. This interactive map is a graphic way of showing the community the large scale of projects being delivered across our region.

The interactive map has been developed using a free of charge Google map which provides an easy to use tool to staff. It is also a tool that our customers are familiar with and is easily linked to Council's website.

This project has been part of a continued effort by Council to keep the community informed and engaged about what is happening across the local government area.
